

THE WILD HUNT: Capture the Dragon or Panda

Objective:

- Attract new and returning Baccarat players.
- Increase revenue through extended play and side bets.

Promotion Details

The Promotion runs from May 1st 12:00 pm to June 19th 8:00 pm. (7-week duration)

The Baccarat Tournament Draw takes place on June 19th at 8:08 pm

During the 7-week promotion from May 1st 12:00 pm to June 19th 8:00 pm, patrons wagering on the EZ Baccarat side bets (Dragon or Panda) can earn a ballot entry ticket for a draw to play in a Baccarat tournament held on June 19th at 8:08 pm with the grand prize of \$8,888 for 1st, \$3,333 for 2nd and \$1,111 for 3rd.

How to Enter

A ballot entry ticket is given to a winning \$10 or more side bet on Dragon or Panda.

For all winning side bets of \$10 or more on Dragon or Panda, the player will receive 1 ballot entry.

For all winning side bets of \$100 or more on the Dragon or Panda, the player will receive 3 ballot entries.

For all winning side bets of \$200 or more on the Dragon or Panda, the player will receive 7 ballot entries.

****Double the ballots if Panda kills Dragon bet, all Panda winning bets receive double the ballots. ****

E.g. Three card Banker 7 beaten by 3 card Player 8

No Spend Necessary

Draw Details

- All ballot tickets will be submitted into a locked brass drum under surveillance in the high limit room. Players have from May 1st to June 19th to earn ballot tickets and to submit into the draw.
- [All free ballot entries made digitally through the QR code will be transferred to a physical ballot ticket and submitted prior to the draw date.](#)
- The draw will be held on June 19th at 8:08 pm to select 14 semi-finalists to play in a Baccarat tournament for a chance to win \$8,888 for 1st place, \$3,333 for 2nd place and \$1,111 for 3rd place.
- Participants must be present during the drawing to play in the Baccarat tournament.

The Baccarat Tournament Rules

- The tournament consists of 14 players during the qualifying round with 8 hands to be played. The final round will consist of a maximum of 7 players with 8 hands to be played.
- The tournament seating arrangements will be determined by the order the players were chosen during the draw. E.g., First person picked during the draw will be the first to choose any of the 14 seats available.
- For the first 7 of 8 hands, players will follow a betting order. E.g., Seat 1, first to bet, seat 2 second to bet. Seat 2 cannot wager until seat 1 has completed their betting. Seat 7 will be the last to bet in the first round. Next round seat 2 will be first to bet then seat 3, seat 4 and so on. The betting order will allow for all players to have the advantage of betting last for each hand.
- Each of the 14 semi-finalist players will start with \$25,000 in tournament chips, consisting of \$100 to \$1,000 denomination tournament chips and will play a total of 8 hands during the qualifying round.
- During the entire tournament, both qualifying and final round, all players must make a minimum bet of \$100 on either Player or Banker. There is no maximum bet. Side bets and tie bets are not mandatory.
- Players will be eliminated once their chip stack is \$0.
- At the commencement of the 8th hand, the top 7 players with the highest amount of chips remaining will advance to play in the final round. Must have chip(s) to advance.
- Each finalist player will start with \$25,000 in tournament chips, consisting of \$100 to \$1,000 denomination tournament chips and will play a total of 8 hands in the same fashion as the qualifying round.
- The 8th hand in both the qualifying and final rounds will be considered a mystery hand to which every remaining player will have their amount written down in secret. (The amount wagered on Player or Banker and any side bets) Once all players have completed this process, the dealer will begin to set up their bets with their remaining chip stack and according to what was written down in secret.
- Cash prizes will be awarded to the top 3 players with the highest remaining chip stack amount.
- In the event there is a tie in the remaining chip stack amount between players for a cash prize, an additional hand will be played in similar fashion as the previous mystery hand until a winner is determined.

General Rules

- Anyone who is 18 years of age or older can participate except for employees of Cowboys Casino and AGLC.
- All ballots are the property of Cowboys Casino. Ballots which have been obtained or made through fraudulent means, or which are illegible, altered, reproduced, mutilated, or irregular, are subject to disqualification. Cowboys Casino will not be responsible for ballots lost, destroyed, misdirected, or delayed for any reason whatsoever.
- All free ballot entries made digitally through the QR code will be transferred to a physical ballot ticket and submitted prior to the draw taking place.
- One free ballot entry per person will be submitted. Duplicates entries made through the QR code will not be accepted.
- The digital ballot entry must have first and last name along with a phone number or email address.
- Government ID required for confirmation on all participants drawn.
- All cash prizes will be awarded to the top 3 players with the highest remaining chip stack amount after the completion of the 8th hand of the final round.
- Players wishing to evenly split the prize amount will do so at their own discretion at the commencement of the final round. Cowboys' casino will not be responsible for amalgamating the cash prizes for an even split share.
